Hearing Assistance During Worship

With our return to the sanctuary, we have access to our hearing assistant loop. This technology allows people with hearing aids equipped with T-Coil technology to hear the service through their hearing aids. If you know you have T-coil technology, plan to turn on the T-coil via your phone on Sunday morning. You may have to ask your audiologist if you have this technology and how to turn it on.

1st Presbyterian Church in Champaign, Il. is equipped with a Hearing Loop. To receive the signal directly in a hearing aid, a dedicated program with a T-coil is required.

For RITE or open-tube fit BTE instruments & near normal low frequency hearing, program a "T" only setting and an MT setting for closed mold fittings. Please ask your patient if a gain adjustment of the T-coil is needed at a follow-up appointment.

Contributions

Total June contributions: \$50.1K from plate and pledge plus \$7.9K from prepaid= \$58K This is \$22.1K less than last year and \$7.1K under budget. Total contributions YTD, including prorated prepaid pledges: \$417.3K which is \$26.2K less than last year and \$26.7K over budget. At 50% of the year, we have 59.5% of the budgeted contributions, including all prepaid contributions.

Expenses


June expenses were \$62.1K, which is \$13.2K less than last year and \$16.9K under budget. Expenses YTD are \$503.8K, which is \$7.9K less than last year and \$29.8K over budget. At 50% of the year, we have spent 53.2% of the budget.


Balance YTD


Expenses exceeded revenue by \$3.8K in June Session Designated Funds: \$1,095,858 which is \$32.6K more than last month.
